

Princess Lalla Amina to represent Morocco at Shafallah Center international forum



Rabat - Princess Lalla Amina, Chairwoman of the Moroccan League for Child Protection (LMPE), of Special Olympics Morocco, and member of the International Special Olympics Advisory Council, will represent Morocco at the 4th Annual International Forum of the Shafallah Center for Children with Special Needs, due on April 19-22 in Doha, Qatar.



Several First Ladies and eminent personalities will partake in the Forum which schedules visits to the Center's technical, medical and social facilities, in addition to exposés on behavioural changes, communication through art, functional therapy and the usage of music in psycho-pedagogy, a statement of the LMPE said.

This event includes several conferences and round tables on autonomy, individual independence, equal opportunities for the disabled, the role of family in the social integration of people with special needs and the importance of international programmes in promoting the employment of these people.

The Forum also schedules several debates on the protection of the rights and the dignity of people with disability, on the basis of equal opportunities in all political, economic, social and cultural areas, the source said.
