DOHA: Students at the Shafallah Centre have prepared presentations which they will perform in front of H H Sheikha Mozah bint Nasser Al Missned on the first day of the fourth Annual International Forum from on April 20.

Jamal Aridhi, music instructor at Shafallah, said a choir, which has around 12 members, will perform during the main forum, along with some individual performances.

Aridhi said one of the students, Ibrahim Atallah, who has hearing problems, will play on the piano some of the pieces of Ludwig van Beethoven and Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart.

Fourteen-year-old student Noora Said, who has been diagnosed with autism, will display 18 pieces of her art works at the centre during the event.
