

Princess Lalla Amina to partake in International Shafallah Forum



Doha - Princess Lalla Amina, Chairwoman of the Moroccan League for Child Protection (LMPE) and Special Olympics Morocco, and member of the International Special Olympics Advisory Council, arrived on Sunday evening in Doha to represent Morocco at the 4th Annual International Forum of the Shafallah Center for Children with Special Needs, which will kick off Monday.



The three-day event, held under the theme “achieving independence”, will bring together several first ladies and eminent personalities from around the world.

The event will feature several conferences and roundtables on the means to inspire disabled individuals to achieve maximum independence, equal opportunities for the disabled, the role of family in the social integration of people with special needs and the importance of international programmes in promoting the employment of this category.

The forum will also examine the means to protect the rights and the dignity of people with disabilities, on the basis of equal opportunities in political, economic, social and cultural fields.
